

## Bayside Centennial Committee

Agenda for Mtg. to be held on 5/26/2013, Sunday, 10 AM, Village office. Expected duration: 2 hours. Refreshments (e.g. coffee, tea, etc.) welcomed.

1. Reintroduce members and introduce new members
2. Next meetings: 7/7/13, 10 AM Village Office; 8/11/2013, 10 AM Village Office
3. Remind committee that we are drafting a proposal, or alternate proposals to be presented as a warrant at the NVC Annual Meeting
4. Report that \$500 has been allocated by the Board of Overseers as seed money for the committee.
5. Review mission and goal statements. Revise and/or accept by consensus
6. Open discussion on the scope of the event - Simple and intra-village? More extensive and local? Grand and regional?
7. Open discussion on time and duration of the celebrations to be held at least during the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of August, 2015. Leave item for further discussion, perhaps aiming for a decision by consensus at the August meeting, before the NVC Annual Meeting.
8. Open discussion about celebratory events. Proponents of particular events might present a short description for further discussion among the group. We should begin to consider effort and costs for a particular event as well as expected attendance of various constituencies in the village. Ideas on the table:

Dedications of village infrastructure improvements

Service activities (e.g. raising funds during event for Food Pantry, Cancer Orgs, Environmental, etc.)

Fly-by with banner

Film series at the Community Center or outdoors on the green

Northport theatre presentation

Methodist-style hymnal sing-in  
Chautauqua lecture series  
Historical video on Bayside

9. Establish subcommittee to create and distribute a questionnaire for villagers.
10. Open discussion on the use or appointment of an event planner/coordinator.  
Decision by consensus.
11. Itemize action steps to be accomplished before the next meeting.
12. Looking forward: by the end of summer 2013 we should have a plan accepted by the village community at the Annual Meeting. During fall and winter 2013 we should be actively planning and throughout 2014 we should be garnering resources, making reservations of participants and raising needed funds.
